Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Note

The Masonic Order probably had a presence in St. Andrews, New Brunswick prior to 1800. The Eastern Star Lodge No. 37 was formally recognized by the Grand Lodge of Nova Scotia on 29 August 1814, and the St. Andrews Royal Arch Chapter was established. In 1868 the English warrant was surrendered and the lodge became known as Saint Mark's No. 5 of the Grand Lodge of New Brunswick.

Custodial history

The certificate was received by the Archives on 21 January 2004

Scope and content

Certificate of "The Grand Lodge of the Ancient and Honorable Fraternity of Free and Accepted Masons of New Brunswick, St. Marks Lodge, St. Andrews", 1875 of being received into freemasonry in NB.
