Scope and content:

Ship log book of expenses. (1820-1859). Incoming and outgoing dry goods shipments. Pilotage, repairs, postage, bills, and wages. Ports of call include St. Andrews, N.B.; Berbice; Bristol; Liverpool; Naples; Palermo, Kingston Jamaica; The Island of Trinidad; Bangor, Maine; Boston; Demerara; Honduras; and St. Thomas and Montego Bay, Jamaica. It is apparently multiple vessels, the brig John Dunn is named in 1824. The first couple pages contain a list of deaths and marriages.
