Scope and content:

A booklet which contains an outline of a legal act dated May 22 1868 which appointed Fishery Officers in Canada and outlined their duties, as well as the issuing of fishery leases and licenses, regulations for specific fisheries such as cod, whaling, salmon, and others, possession of fish, and the legal ramifications of damaging fishing areas. A few amendments to this act from April 8 1875 are also included, along with an act dated May 23 1873 which prohibited rubbish which could obstruct navigation from being thrown into navigable streams and rivers.
