Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Kaye Walsh was the District Commissioner of the St. Andrews Girl Guides. She was appointed to that position in 1954 and was closely involved with several notable events involving the St. Andrews Girl Guides in following years. In 1956 she was the leader of a group of St. Andrews Girl Guides who attended Provincial Patrol Leaders Camp at Lake Utopia, in 1962 she was the leader of a group of St. Andrews Girl Guides who visited a cabana in Mexico, and in 1966 she visited Guide Headquarters in London. In 1970 she was appointed to the position of St. Andrews Division Guide Trainer.

Scope and content

3 boxes of Girl Guides of the Passamaquoddy division administrative material, training material, material from special events, and scrapbooks. Also includes some documents from the Sea Rangers of the S.R.S. Haida, and administrative documents from St. Stephen, Milltown, Pennfield, St. George, Blacks Harbour and Deer Island Girl Guide and Brownie troops, as well as a scrapbook belonging to Kaye Walsh used for a trip to Mexico.

Notes

Physical condition

Most of the material has frayed or bent edges, and the bindings of many of the scrapbooks are coming undone. Some material also displays water damage that makes some sections illegible, and some material may need to be flattened.

Series MC 460-MS1: Girl Guide/Brownie Scrapbooks

Date: [n.d.] (creation)

<u>Scope and content</u>: Various scrapbooks which were used by Girl Guides and Brownies. The contents of the scrapbooks include outlines of exercises and other educational material for Girl Guides and Brownies as well as photos. There is also a pair of scrapbooks titled "Girl Guide History" and "Origin and History

of Guiding in Canada" which contain photos and newspaper clippings related to the history of the Girl Guides.

Series MC 460-MS2: Sea Rangers Material

<u>Date</u>: 1922-1989 (creation)

Scope and content: Material related to the administration and training of the Sea Rangers division of the Girl Guides for the Passamaquoddy region, with a particular focus on the crew of the S.R.S. (Sea Ranger Ship) Haida. The different types of material include manuals and guides, pamphlets, articles, clippings, pictures, notes, invoices, and reports. There is also a lot of material related to the history of the H.M.C.S. Haida Canadian Destroyer-Class ship, which the S.R.S. Haida is named after.

Series MC 460-MS3: Camping Material

Date: 1951-1976 (creation)

<u>Scope and content</u>: Material related to Passamaquoddy division Girl Guide's camping trips, including documents from camp advisor's conferences, documents related to camp operation, correspondence, song sheets, clippings from articles on the camp trips, photos, reports, handbooks, postcards, press releases, programs, and a few scrapbooks. There are also a few handcrafted souvenir items inserted into the folders.

<u>Scope and content</u>: Material related to Girl Guide and Brownie training. The different types of material include clippings, correspondence, poems, notes, informational documents for prospective Girl Guides, documents on the history of Girl Guides, instructional books and booklets for Girl Guides as well as other publications, song sheets, certificates and forms, prayers, and a scrapbook of newspaper and magazine clippings related to the history of Guiding in Britain.

<u>Scope and content</u>: Material related to the administration of the Passamaquoddy branch of the Girl Guides and Brownies. The different types of material include the by-laws of the St. Andrews Girl Guides,

correspondence, programs, pamphlets, registration forms, notes on Girl Guide activities, meeting minutes, agendas, and various types of reports on Girl Guide branch activities. There are also a few folders containing census reports, activity reports, financial documents, and guider warrant and pack registration forms for Girl Guides in St. Stephen, Milltown, Pennfield, St. George, Blacks Harbor, and Deer Island. Lastly, a copy of the Policy Organization and Rules of the Girl Guides of Canada from 1993 is also included.

<u>Scope and content</u>: Material related to Girl Guides, Brownies, and Sea Rangers special events. The types of items include newspaper and magazine articles on ceremonies and events as well as photos from the events. Also included are a pair of guestbooks which were used at various Girl Guide events in St. Andrews, one of which contains testimonies by former Girl Guides on their experiences.
