NOTICE

This Individual Liquor Permit Book is issued only upon presentation of National Registration Certificate or other approved Identification. It is not transferable and cannot be used by any person other than the within named holder.

This Permit Book is not replaceable if lost, damaged or destroyed except by special written permission of the Board and only upon satisfactory proof of the circumstances and on payment of the prescribed fee.

Because of decreased supplies of spirits, wine and beer available to the Board owing to wartime restrictions, the Board cannot give any assurance that there will be sufficient stocks at any time to provide the authorized allowances.

Coupons contained in the Book are valid only if detached by a clerk in a Government Store at the time a purchase is made. Out-of-date coupons or coupons which are not yet due are not valid.

Please keep this Permit Book in the envelope supplied with it. Soiled or damaged Permit Books are liable to forfeiture.
