ORDERS FOR PERSONNEL SENTENCED TO CB

1. Personnel undergoing CB will be referred to as defaulters:
 - a. The defaulter will attend normal Squadron parades and training periods, and perform all normal Squadron duties and fatigues. In addition, he will be required to attend extra parades and fatigues as detailed in Annex B;
 - b. A defaulter undergoing CB does not have canteen privileges of any kind. He will not enter any canteen or recreational area during his period of punishment unless to purchase cleaning equipment with permission of the ROS;
 - c. The defaulter will not consume any alcoholic beverages during his time of punishment;
 - d. The defaulter will remain in the defaulters' room at all times except when given permission by the ROS to enter another room. Under no circumstances will the defaulter be allowed to lounge or sit in the room provided for duty personnel;
 - e. The defaulter will sleep in the beds provided in the Defaulters Room. Under no circumstances will defaulters sleep on spare beds or on the floor;
 - f. The defaulter will at all times be properly dressed in the prescribed uniform for the time of day;
 - g. The defaulter will occupy a bed space in the Defaulters Room commencing the day he is sentenced;
 - h. The defaulter will parade at the Defaulters Room N-40 at 1800 hours his first day with all of the kit listed at Annex C. Kit will be laid out as detailed in Annex C in defaulters' quarters and inspected by the Regimental Orderly Officer (ROO). The ROS will list all deficiencies and non-serviceable items in the defaulters' register. The defaulter will work on his kit on the first night of punishment, except for the drill period and the staff parades at 1800 and 2200 hours. On subsequent days, kit will not be inspected at the 1800 hours staff parade;
 - j. On the second day of punishment the defaulter will acquire all items deficient or considered non-serviceable. These items will be checked at the 2200 hours staff parade to ensure that the kit is complete;

- k. The defaulter will have the alert kit listed at Appendix 1 to Annex C at his place of duty during working hours and in the defaulters' quarters during silent hours;
- m. The defaulter will not leave the Base area unless he is required to do so during the course of squadron duties. If the defaulter is required to be off Base during staff parades he must personally inform the ROS of the details and report to the ROS on his return;
- n. No reading material will be brought to the defaulters' room other than current newspapers, new publications or training reference material. No extra personal items such as radios, record players or televisions will be permitted in the defaulters' quarters; and
- p. During inclement weather, drill will be conducted in Building N-50.

DEFAULTERS' ROUTINE

1. Daily - Weekdays:

- 0530 hours - Reveille, wash and shave, make bed (hospital style) and clean quarters.
- 0600 hours - Stand by his bed. ROS will inspect and note any faults in the defaulters' register. Dress will be work dress. Assembled Alert kit will be laid on bed. Lockers will be open and laid out as detailed in ROR Form - Locker Kit Layout.
- 0630 hours - Breakfast.
- 0730 hours - Report to squadrons for squadron parade.
- 0730 - 1630 hours - Normal squadron duties.
- 1800 hours - Staff parade at the Defaulters Room.
- ROO to inspect.
- Dress: Combat as detailed in paragraph 1 of Annex C.
- Followed by 30 minute drill period (note - on first day of CB, kit will be laid out as detailed in ROR Form - Kit Layout Diagram).
- 1900 - 2130 hours - Fatigues as ordered by RSM. Dress: coveralls, beret, combat boots.
- 2130 - 2200 hours - Work on kit in defaulters' quarters, lay out kit, prepare for staff parade.
- 2200 hours - Staff parade in defaulters' quarters.
- ROO to inspect.
- Dress: No 3 Uniform as detailed in paragraph 2 to Annex C.
- Kit laid out as detailed in ROR Form - Kit Layout Diagram.
- Lockers open as detailed in ROR Form - Locker Kit Layout.
- 2215 - 2245 hours - Work on kit, correct all faults detected on Staff Parades.
- 2245 hours - Shower.
- 2300 hours - Lights out.

2. Saturdays and Holidays:

- 0700 hours - Revellie, wash and shave, make bed, (hospital style) and clean defaulters' room.
- 0730 hours - Stand by his bed. ROS will inspect and note any faults in the defaulters' register. Dress will be work dress. Kit will be laid out as detailed in ROR Form - Kit Layout Diagram. Lockers will be open and laid out as detailed in ROR Form - Locker Kit Layout. (Photo in CB Room).
- 0800 - 0830 hours - Breakfast.
- 0830 - 0930 hours - Police outside of single men's quarters as detailed by ROS. Dress: Coveralls, beret and combat boots.
- 0930 hours - Parade at Defaulters' Room under the ROS. Dress: Coveralls, beret and combat boots.
- 0940 - 1200 hours - Fatigues as detailed by the RSM under the direction of the ROS. Dress: Coveralls, beret and combat boots.
- 1200 - 1300 hours - Lunch.
- 1300 hours - Parade at Defaulters' Room under the ROS. Dress: Coveralls, beret and combat boots.
- 1310 - 1630 hours - Fatigues as directed by the RSM under the direction of the ROS. Dress: Coveralls, beret and combat boots.
- 1630 - 1800 hours - Supper, prepare for staff parade.
- 1800 hours - Staff parade at the Defaulters' Room.
- ROO to inspect.
- Dress: Combat as detailed in paragraph 1 of Annex C.
- Followed by 30 minute drill period (note - on first day of CB kit will be laid out as detailed in ROR Form - Kit Layout Diagram).
- 1900 - 2130 hours - Fatigues as detailed by the RSM under the direction of the ROS. Dress: Coveralls, beret and combat boots.
- 2130 - 2200 hours - Work on kit in defaulters' quarters, layout kit, prepare for staff parade.
- 2200 hours - Staff parade at Defaulters' Room.
- ROO to inspect.
